Dearest Sisters,

I come to you at the conclusion of our  $2^{nd}$  Extended General Council, to communicate the journey that we intend to carry out in preparation to the Seminar on the ministry of pastoral care, which as you know, has been indicated by our  $7^h$  General Chapter.

We desire to propose to all the Pastorelle and all the communities, an itinerary of Lectio divina *on five texts* from the Letters of St. Paul, which will be <u>from October 2007 to December 2008</u>, in order to prepare all of us to the Seminar through the prayerful reading of the Word.
